CLASSROOM EXPECTATIONS

1. Teachers will post activities and assignments for the upcoming week via Google Classroom by Friday at midnight. **The first posting will occur on Friday, May 1st by midnight for the week of May 4th-May 8th**. We are taking this "week at a time" approach so that you can best organize your time. Teachers may post additional activities throughout the week based on Google Meet sessions.

2. Students are required to complete ALL work assigned by teachers each week.

3. You will have live video and/or interactive experiences over the course of the week for 90 minutes for each class you have via Google Classroom. Meetings on M/W/F will be for 30 minutes and meetings on T/TH will be for 45 minutes. Teachers will post each of your class schedules on Google Classroom.

4. Teachers will also establish virtual office hours weekly, where you can engage in real-time with your teachers either through video conferencing, chat functions, or email. Teachers will share these times in their Google classrooms, as well as the best means to access them (by appointment, etc.).

5. All of the assignments for the week will be due by Friday at 4:00 PM as required by the teacher. Should an emergency arise this week that requires a delay in this submission, students should email teachers, copying their parents/guardians on their emails.

6. If teachers do not receive an assignment from you for a week, they will contact you and your family to determine what challenges may exist and how we can support you in participating fully.

7. It is your responsibility to attend all of your weekly Google Meet sessions and complete all assignments for each class.

8. As a reminder, grades will go live on Monday, May 4th, and run for six weeks through the last day of school on June 12th.

ATTENDANCE

1. Attendance will be taken by all teachers every day. **Attendance is mandatory through Friday, June 12th.**

2. Teachers will make calls or send emails to all parents of students who do not attend virtual lessons held via Google Meet.

3. If a student misses 2 virtual classes, he or she will be referred to his or her grade level counselor for parent calls/virtual meetings with parents.

GRADING

1. Teachers have updated all grades in the grade book to reflect grades submitted before school closure on Friday, March 13th.

2. Moving forward, teachers will update grades every 2 weeks for the remainder of the year. The grade update dates will be Friday, May 12th, Friday, May 26th, and Final grades (due date will be sent out with advanced notice).

3. All Weekly Assignments will be entered into the "Tests" category in the grade book.

4. As a reminder, all Edgenuity classes need to be completed by **Friday, May 29th.**

5. It is at the teacher's discretion whether or not to accept late work.
